

Transport Department Notice

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements at Flower Market Road Area, Mong Kok

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the Police's crowd management measures at Mong Kok Flower Market Road area before Lunar New Year 2026, the temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented as follows:-

(A) Temporary road closures and traffic diversions

- (I) The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 8.00 a.m. on 7 February 2026 to 8.00 a.m. on 17 February 2026 (except vehicles with closed road permits):-
- (i) Flower Market Road;
 - (ii) Yuen Ngai Street;
 - (iii) Yuen Po Street; and
 - (iv) Prince Edward Road West Service Road between Sai Yee Street and Yuen Po Street.
- (II) Depending on the prevailing traffic situation and crowd condition, the following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 8.00 a.m. on 7 February 2026 to 8.00 a.m. on 17 February 2026 at short notice by Police:-
- (i) the section of Sai Yee Street between Prince Edward Road West Service Road and Boundary Street;
 - (ii) the section of Fa Yuen Street between Prince Edward Road West Service Road and Boundary Street;
 - (iii) the section of Playing Field Road between Tung Choi Street and Sai Yee Street; and
 - (iv) the section of Prince Edward Road West Service Road between Nathan Road and Sai Yee Street.

All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making U-turn from Prince Edward Road West westbound near Nathan Road onto Prince Edward Road West Service Road.

(B) Temporary conversion of taxi stand to taxi pick-up/ drop-off point

The taxi stand on Fa Yuen Street near Prince Edward Road West Service Road will be temporarily converted to taxi pick-up/drop-off point from 8.00 a.m. on 7 February 2026 to 8.00 a.m. on 17 February 2026.

(C) Temporary suspension of parking spaces

- (I) The following metered parking spaces will be temporarily suspended from 8.00 a.m. on 7 February 2026 to 8.00 a.m. on 17 February 2026:-
- (i) The metered parking spaces on Fa Yuen Street between Prince Edward Road West Service Road and Boundary Street;
 - (ii) The metered parking spaces on Tung Choi Street between Prince Edward Road West Service Road and Boundary Street; and

- (iii) The metered parking spaces on Playing Field Road between Tung Choi Street and Sai Yee Street.
- (II) The following motorcycle parking spaces and disabled parking spaces will be temporarily suspended from 8.00 a.m. on 7 February 2026 to 8.00 a.m. on 17 February 2026:-
 - (i) The motorcycle parking spaces on Tung Choi Street near Playing Field Road;
 - (ii) The motorcycle parking spaces on Playing Field Road between Fa Yuen Street and Tung Choi Street; and
 - (iii) The motorcycle parking spaces under Prince Edward Road West Flyover between Tung Choi Street and Sai Yee Street.
 - (iv) The disabled parking spaces on Fa Yuen Street near Boundary Street; and
 - (v) The disabled parking space on Playing Field Road near Tung Choi Street.

(D) Temporary relocation/ suspension of bus and GMB stops

- (I) From 5.00 p.m. on 7 February 2026 to 8.00 a.m. on 17 February 2026

The bus stops of KMB route nos. 1, 1A, 203C and Cross-harbour route no. 104; and GMB stops of Kowloon GMB route nos. 12, 17M and 69A outside Mong Kok Police Station, Tung Choi Street will be temporarily relocated northward to No. 225 Tung Choi Street between Playing Field Road and Boundary Street.

- (II) From 5.00 p.m. to 1.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 14 and 15 February 2026; and
From 2.00 p.m. to 3.00 a.m. of the following day on 16 February 2026

The bus stops of KMB route nos. 1, 1A, 3C, 42, 95, 203C, 203S, N216; CTB route no. 20A and Cross-harbour route no. 104; and GMB stops of Kowloon GMB route nos. 12, 17M, 46, 66S, 69A, 70 and 70A on No. 191 Prince Edward Road West outside Royal Plaza Hotel will be temporarily suspended.

(E) Attention and Appeal

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. Notices will also be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the above temporary public transport arrangements. Adjustment of the above road closures and traffic diversions, or other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversions, alterations and suspension of public transport services, will be implemented by the Police depending on the crowd and traffic condition in the areas.
