

Transport Department Notice
Road Closure Arrangements for Yue Man Square and Tung Yan Street in Kwun Tong

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the underground utilities diversion works of the Urban Renewal Authority's "Kwun Tong Town Centre 2.0" project, the following traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Kwun Tong from 28 June 2026 (Sunday) until further notice:

1. From 0.00 am on 28 June 2026

(I) Road Closure

Yue Man Square and Tung Yan Street will be closed to all vehicular traffic.

(II) Traffic Diversion

- (a) Affected vehicles on Hip Wo Street northbound heading to Ngau Tau Kok Road will be diverted via Mut Wah Street westbound and Hong Ning Road southbound;
- (b) Affected vehicles on Yuet Wah Street heading to Ngau Tau Kok Road will be diverted via Hip Wo Street northbound, Wan Hon Street westbound, Shui Wo Street, Fu Yan Street, Shung Yan Street westbound and Hong Ning Road southbound;
- (c) Affected vehicles on Tsui Ping Road westbound heading to Ngau Tau Kok Road will be diverted via Hip Wo Street southbound, Wan Hon Street westbound, Shui Wo Street, Fu Yan Street, Shung Yan Street westbound and Hong Ning Road southbound;
- (d) Affected vehicles on Hiu Kwong Street westbound heading to Ngau Tau Kok Road will be diverted via Hip Wo Street northbound and Hong Ning Road southbound;
and
- (e) Affected vehicles on Sau Nga Road westbound heading to Ngau Tau Kok Road will be diverted via Hip Wo Street northbound and Hong Ning Road southbound.

(III) Public Transport Service Arrangements

Relocation of Bus and Green Minibus Stopping Points

- (a) The bus stops on Yue Man Square for KMB Route Nos. 14B and 16M, and XHT Route Nos. 606, 606A, 606X and 641 will be relocated to Hip Wo Street northbound near Tung Yan Street;
- (b) The bus stops on Yue Man Square for KMB Route Nos. 13M, 23M, 28B, 95M and N293, and XHT Route Nos. 619 and N619 will be relocated to Mut Wah Street westbound near Hip Wo Street;
- (c) The bus stops on Yue Man Square for KMB Route Nos. 1A, 13D, 13P and 89 will be relocated to Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange;
- (d) The bus stop on Yue Man Square for KMB Route No. 89X will be relocated to Kwun Tong Road westbound near Tsun Yip Lane; and
- (e) The GMB stop on Yue Man Square for Kowloon GMB Route No. 62S and New Territories GMB Route No. 501S will be relocated to Hip Wo Street northbound near Tung Yan Street.

Re-routeing of Bus and Green Minibus

- (a) KMB Route Nos. 1A, 13D, 13P (Mong Kok bound) and 89 (Shatin bound) will be diverted via Mut Wah Street, Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange, Mut Wah Street and then resume the original routeing;
- (b) KMB Route Nos. 13M, 14B, 95M (Ngau Tau Kok bound), 16M (Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange bound), 23M (Lok Wah bound), 28B (Kai Tak bound), N293 (Mong Kok bound), XHT Route Nos. 606, 606A, 606X (Choi Wan/Kowloon Bay bound), 619, N619 (Shun Lee bound) and 641 (Kai Tak bound) will be diverted via Mut Wah Street and then resume the original routeing;
- (c) KMB Route No. 89X (Shatin bound) will be diverted via Hip Wo Street, Kwun Tong Road and then resume the original routeing;
- (d) GMB Route Nos. 23B, 23M, 62S and 63 (Lam Tin/Yau Tong bound) will be diverted via Hip Wo Street, Kwun Tong Road and then resume the original routeing; and

(e) GMB Route No. 62S (Tsim Sha Tsui bound) will be diverted via Hip Wo Street, Mut Wah Street and then resume the original routeing.

Relocation of Cross Boundary Coach Drop-off Point

The drop-off point on Yue Man Square for cross boundary coaches will be relocated to Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange.

Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand at Yue Man Square will be suspended.

2. From 0.00 am to 5.30 am on 28 June 2026

Traffic Diversion

Public light buses from Hip Wo Street southbound heading to Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange will be temporarily diverted via Hoi Yuen Road roundabout, Hip Wo Street northbound, and back to Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. Motorists are advised to observe the instruction and drive with utmost care. Notices will also be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the above arrangement.
