# <u>Temporary Traffic Arrangement in Kam Sheung Road Station Public Transport Interchange, Yuen</u> <u>Long</u>

To facilitate the Kam Sheung Road Station Package One Property Development, the following traffic and transport arrangement will be implemented at Kam Sheung Road Station Public Transport Interchange from 03:00 a.m. on 22 September 2019 to 6:00 p.m. on 21 December 2019. The section of northern Public Transport Interchange will be temporarily closed. All bus stops, GMB stands, taxi stands and cross-boundary coach stand will be relocated. The arrangement will be as follows (Refer to Figure 1):

# (B) <u>KMB</u>

Bus route nos. 54, 64K, 64S and 77K (drop-off only) will be relocated to the fourth eastern most bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

The exiting bus stop of bus route no.251A will remain unchanged (at the second eastern most bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange).

## (C) The NT Taxi

The stand will be relocated to the front of the first eastern most bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

## (D) The Urban Taxi

The stand will be relocated to the rear of the first eastern most bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

## (E) The Cross-boundary Coach Service

The stand will be relocated to the front of the lay-by at carriageway at the western most side of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

Appropriate traffic signs will be placed on site to guide passengers and motorists.
