# Introduction of KMB/ NWFB Route No. 980X (Wu Kai Sha Station – Wan Chai (Hennessy Road)/ Admiralty Station (East))

Passengers are advised that with effect from 20 February 2017 (Monday), KMB and NWFB will introduce a new bus route numbered as 980X (Wu Kai Sha Station – Wan Chai (Hennessy Road)/ Admiralty Station (East)). Details are as follows:

## I. Route

Wu Kai Sha Station to Wan Chai (Hennessy Road): via Sha On Street, Sai Sha Road, Kam Ying Road, Ma On Shan Road, Sai Sha Road, Ma On Shan Town Centre Bus Terminus, Sai Sha Road, Hang Hong Street, Ma On Shan Road, Tate's Cairn Highway, \*(Sha Lek Highway, Sha Tin Wai Road, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road, Tai Po Road – Sha Tin), Tsing Sha Highway, Lai Po Road, Lin Cheung Road, West Kowloon Highway, Western Harbour Crossing, Connaught Road West, Connaught Road Central, Rumsey Street, Des Voeux Road Central, Chater Road, Murray Road, Queensway and Hennessy Road (terminating near O'Brien Road).

\* Departures may be diverted via Sha Lek Road, Sha Tin Road, Lion Rock Tunnel Road, Hung Mui Kuk Road and Che Kung Miu Road; or Shek Mun Interchange, Tai Chung Kiu Road, Lion Rock Tunnel Road and Tai Po Road – Tai Wai, non-stop depending on traffic condition.

Admiralty Station (East) to Wu Kai Sha Station: via Rodney Street, Drake Street, Tamar Street, Harcourt Road, Cotton Tree Drive slip road, Lambeth Walk, Chater Road, Jackson Road, Connaught Road Central, Connaught Road West, Western Harbour Crossing, West Kowloon Highway, Lin Cheung Road, Lai Po Road, Tsing Sha Highway, #(Shing Mun Tunnel Road, Tai Po Road – Sha Tin, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road, Sha Tin Wai Road, Sha Lek Highway), Tate's Cairn Highway, Ma On Shan Road, Hang Hong Street, Sai Sha Road, Ma On Shan Road, Kam Ying Road, Sai Sha Road and Sha On Street.

# Departures may be diverted via Che Kung Miu Road, Hung Mui Kuk Road, Lion Rock Tunnel Road, Sha Tin Road, Sha Lek Highway, non-stop depending on traffic condition.
