Special Traffic Arrangements in Sha Tin for Running Race

Members of the public are advised that in order to facilitate a running race in Sha Tin, the following special traffic arrangements will be implemented on 24 December 2017 (Sunday):

(I) <u>Intermittent Closure of Cycle Track</u>

The following sections of cycle track in Sha Tin and Ma On Shan will be intermittently closed:

- (a) from 7.00 am to 11.30 am, the cycle track near Vista Paradiso, Ma On Shan between Ma On Shan Promenade and Ma On Shan Recreation Ground;
- (b) from 7.00 am to 9.00 am, the cycle track between Hang Tai Road and A Kung Kok Street:
- (c) from 7.00 am to 11.00 am, the cycle track along the western riverside of Shing Mun River Channel between Lion Bridge and the unnamed bridge outside Sha Tin Sewage Treatment Works; and
- (d) from $7.00~\rm am$ to $10.00~\rm am$, the cycle track connecting On King Street Park and Shing Mun River Promenade Garden No. 2.

During the closure of the cycle track, cyclists are required to dismount upon entering / leaving the above mentioned cycle track. Cyclists may also use the cycle track along Tai Po Road - Sha Tin, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road, Sand Martin Bridge, Tai Chung Kiu Road and the unnamed bridge outside Sha Tin Sewage Treatment Works to travel between Sha Tin, Tai Po or Ma On Shan.

(II) Intermittent Closure of Road

Mui Tsz Lam Road will be intermittently closed from 7.00 am to 11.00 am.

Please exercise care and patience and take heed of the instructions given by police officers on site. Appropriate traffic signs will be put up to guide the public. Implementation of the above road closure and cycle track closures will be adjusted by police officers at the time depending on crowd and traffic conditions in the area.
