Hong Kong residents aged 65 or above must apply for a JoyYou Card in phases during designated period to continue to benefit from the \$2 Scheme.


Each eligible applicant will only be issued with one JoyYou Card.

Depending on the application progress, the Government will further announce the date to cease covering Anonymous Elder Octopus and Personalised Octopus in the \$2 Scheme.

Hong Kong residents aged 60-64 who have applied and received a JoyYou Card, please continue to use the existing JoyYou Card and there is no need to re-apply for a new one.

How to apply for a JoyYou Card

Accept application via mobile app / distribute application form from June 1, 2022



Via Octopus App



Applicants should send the completed application form with a copy of their Hong Kong identity card and a 1.5 x 2 inch colour passport photo (with white or plain light colour background) taken within six months by post to the address specified on the application form. JoyYou Card will be mailed to the correspondence address in Hong Kong given by eligible applicants within four weeks upon receipt of the required information and documents.

Application Fee

- The HKSAR Government subsidises the administrative fee for the first time application of eligible beneficiaries.
- No activation of JoyYou Card is required. JoyYou Card should be reloaded with an amount higher than HK\$50 via existing ways to reload Octopus. The initial reloading amount will include a refundable deposit of HK\$50.
