from April 3, 2026

Targeted beneficiaries
(Hong Kong residents aged 60 or above and eligible

Adult fares ²	Fares payable by beneficiaries under \$2 Scheme
At \$10 or below ³	\$2
Over \$10	“20%” of the adult fare ⁴

- Applicable to interchange journeys⁵.
- If individual transport routes have different adult fares (such as resident/ non-resident fares, holiday/ non-holiday fares, etc.), the “\$2 Flat Rate or 80 Per cent Off” fare under the \$2 Scheme will be calculated based on the adult fares that applies.

- 1 Hong Kong residents aged 60 or above must use a JoyYou Card, while eligible persons with disabilities aged below 60 must use a Personalised Octopus with “Persons with Disabilities Status”, to enjoy the \$2 Scheme.
- 2 Adult fares are based on the adult Octopus fare set by public transport operators and will be adjusted in accordance with transport concessions offered by operators (if applicable).
- 3 If the fare applicable for beneficiaries is below \$2, beneficiaries only need to pay that fare.
- 4 Rounded off to the nearest 10 cents.
- 5 If the interchange journeys are covered under the \$2 Scheme, the fare for the subsequent legs will be calculated based on the adult fares by deducting any interchange concessions offered by the operators while applying the “\$2 Flat Rate or 80 Per cent Off” principle. **“\$2 Flat Rate or 80 Per cent Off”

Adult fares	Fare calculation	Fares payable by beneficiaries
\$8	\$2 flat fare	\$2
\$10		\$2
\$10.8	“20%” of the adult fare*	\$2.2
\$20.2		\$4.0

MTR

Domestic MTR services, including Light Rail and MTR Bus (Northwest New Territories) (Excluding the Airport Express, East Rail Line services to and from Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau and Racecourse Stations, and first-class service of East Rail Line)



Franchised Buses

Franchised bus routes of Kowloon Motor Bus, Citybus, Long Win Bus and New Lantao Bus (Excluding “A” and “NA” routes to the airport, racecourse routes, new long-haul services, designated tourist-oriented routes and the routes on a pre-booking and group hire basis)



Ferries

Designated ferry services (Excluding deluxe class services)



Green Minibuses

All green minibuses routes



Red Minibuses

Designated services of red minibuses and kaitos approved by the Transport Department to join the \$2 Scheme
