## **Seat Belts for Passenger Seats of Non-Franchised Buses**

- 1. To enhance the safety of passengers, the Transport Department now requires non-franchised buses to be provided with seat belt<sup>1</sup> for each passenger seat<sup>2</sup>.
- 2. The above requirement <u>will take effect from 1 December 2021</u> on applications for vehicle type approval of new non-franchised buses. Every non-franchised bus <u>first registered on or after 1 July 2022</u> shall comply with the above requirement in pre-registration examination.
