## I. Route

Horizon Suite Hotel to Tsim Sha Tsui (Hankow Road): via On Chun Street, On Yuen Street, Ma On Shan Road, Sai Sha Road, Hang Hong Street, Ma On Shan Road, Tate's Cairn Highway, Sha Lek Highway, Sha Tin Road, Lion Rock Tunnel Road, Waterloo Road, Princess Margaret Road, Hong Chong Road, Hung Hom Bypass, Salisbury Road, Nathan Road, Middle Road, Kowloon Park Drive, Salisbury Road and Hankow Road.

Tsim Sha Tsui (Hankow Road) to Horizon Suite Hotel: via Hankow Road, Middle Road, Kowloon Park Drive, Salisbury Road, Hung Hom Bypass, Hong Chong Road, Princess Margaret Road, Waterloo Road, Lion Rock Tunnel Road, Sha Tin Road, Sha Lek Highway, Tate's Cairn Highway, Ma On Shan Road, Hang Hong Street, Sai Sha Road, On Yuen Street and On Chun Street.

## II. Stopping Points

Without contravening the Road Traffic Ordinance, boarding/alighting activities should be conducted at the following places (except restricted zones, prohibited zones, bus-only-lanes, bus stops and taxi stands):

- (1) On Chun Street, Horizon Suite Hotel
- (2) Hankow Road, outside YMCA of Hong Kong
