ROBINSON ROAD (BISHOP LEI INTERNATIONAL HOUSE) TO CENTRAL (CIRCULAR) : via Robinson Road, Garden Road, Cotton Tree Drive, Tim Wa Avenue, Lung Wo Road, Man Cheung Street, Connaught Road Central, Harcourt Road, Cotton Tree Drive, Drake Street, Tamar Street, Harcourt Road, Gloucester Road, Fenwick Street, Harbour Road, Fleming Road, Expo Drive East, Expo Drive, Expo Drive Central, Expo Drive East, Lung Wo Road, Convention Avenue, Fenwick Pier Street, Harcourt Road flyover, Cotton Tree Drive, Garden Road and Robinson Road.

**III. STOPPING PLACES**

1. Inside Bishop Lei International House
2. Man Cheung Street westbound near MTR Hong Kong Station  
(Boarding point: Arrival Hall at L2; Alighting point: Departure Hall at G/F) #
3. Lay-by at Drake Street outside Far East Finance Centre
4. Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (Harbour Road Entrance)#
5. Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (Expo Drive Entrance)#

**VII. OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

- Passengers of the service should be restricted to hotel residents only and passengers should be asked to prove their identities before boarding;
- Notice should be placed inside the vehicle and at the stopping point at the hotel to inform passengers the service is for the hotel residents only; and
- The proposed service should not cause traffic congestion in the vicinity.

**VII. VALIDITY**

Validity from 1 September 2025 to 31 August 2027 (The approval for hotel service after the current expiry of Passenger Service Licence on 24 July 2027 is subject to successful renewal of Passenger Service Licence).
