

Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Macao Port Park-and-Ride Scheme

Voice-over script:

Upon the commissioning of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, Hong Kong registered private car owners can join the Macao Port Park-and-Ride Scheme to drive their private cars to Macao via the bridge and park their private cars on short-term basis at the East Car Park of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Frontier Post at Macao Port. They can then travel to the city of Macao by public transport after completing the clearance procedures.

Under the scheme, Hong Kong private cars, without quota requirement, are not required to display a car plate of Macao. Designated drivers are not required to hold a Macao driving licence but have to complete the registration formalities for themselves and their cars during their applications.

Before using the car park for the first time, applicants must apply for the Closed Road Permit from the Transport Department of Hong Kong and the Identification Label issued by the Macao government. Since the Main Bridge of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge is located within the Mainland waters, Hong Kong private cars and their designated drivers travelling between Hong Kong and Macao should also obtain the electronic temporary vehicle licence and the driving permission issued by the Mainland government.

The Transport Department will provide a one-stop service to co-ordinate the applications. It is simple and convenient! Applicants are advised to submit their applications online or by post to save time and to avoid long queue at the Transport Department's Cross Boundary Unit. If you wish to use the counter service, remember to make an appointment in advance at the GovHK website. Each application generally takes about 12 working days to process.

Upon completion of the application procedures, the Transport Department will send the Closed Road Permit and the Identification Label to the successful applicants by post.

Hong Kong private car owners must reserve car parking space at least 6 hours before departure through Macao's designated online platform. During the respective validity periods of the Closed Road Permit and the Identification Label, they are allowed to make multiple reservations of car parking space.

Before departure, you must purchase vehicle insurances as required by Macao

and the Mainland. For details, you can visit the website of the Hong Kong Federation of Insurers. Finally, remember to upload the information of the Mainland vehicle insurance at the Zhuhai's online filing platform for obtaining the Mainland's formal approval of electronic temporary licence and driving permission.

Once you have completed all the above procedures, you are ready to drive to Macao via the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge!
