







NEW PARKING METER

Quick View of New Features



In order to cater for long-term road management need and market trends, the Transport Department has launched a new parking meter. Not only the design has changed, its functions have been enhanced, providing a brand new parking experience to drivers. These enhancements will be a big step forward for Hong Kong in becoming a smart city.

Benefits of New Parking Meter



Real-time Parking Information to Save Time and Eco-friendly

The new parking meter is equipped with space sensors to detect whether a parking space is occupied. Real-time information will be provided to assist motorists in finding vacant parking spaces so as to help reduce traffic generated by vehicles circulating in search of vacant parking spaces, resulting in fewer fuel consumption and vehicle emissions. The information collected by space sensors will be limited to whether the parking spaces are occupied. No personal data nor individual vehicle information will be collected.



Solar Charging Cell

The new parking meters are mainly operated by rechargeable batteries, and solar power is used as auxiliary power. The battery is more durable via renewable energy.



Remote Payment to Extend Parking Time

With "HKeMeter", motorists can get a real-time overview of parking vacancy information for metered parking spaces in Hong Kong, and perform remote top up of parking fees. The relevant real-time information will also be disseminated to motorists via TD's mobile application, "HKeMobility" (mobile / web version) and the government website data.gov.hk.



Multiple Payment Means, Convenient and Flexible

The new parking meters support different electronic payment methods such as physical payment cards (including Octopus, Visa payWave, MasterCard Contactless and UnionPay QuickPass contactless credit cards) and QR code payments (including FPS, AlipayHK, WeChat Pay and UnionPay QR) to pay parking fees on site or top up remotely through the HKeMeter app.
