

Additional Facilitation Measures for Cross-boundary Vehicles Stranded in the Mainland or Macao to Return to Hong Kong for Vehicle Examination

Flowchart

Applicant

[Step 1: Submit an application]

- Submit the completed application form and relevant supporting documents to the Cross Boundary Unit of the Transport Department (TD) in person or by agent through drop-in box, by email or by post

TD

[Step 2: Vet the application and publish a gazette notice]

- **If the application is approved**, publish a gazette notice for the exempted vehicle and issue an approval letter to the applicant, stating that the designated driver may bring along TD's approval letter and drive the designated vehicle on the specified date along the designated route via the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge (HZMB) port to the designated car testing centre which an appointment has been made for vehicle examination
- **If the application is not approved**, contact the applicant for follow-up actions (e.g. supplement documents). The applicant may have to adjust the date of return of the vehicle for further processing on a case by case basis.

Approved designated driver

[Step 3: Drive the vehicle back to Hong Kong on the specified date for vehicle examination]

- Comply with the latest entry requirements of Hong Kong
- Bring along TD's approval letter as well as the completed application form and drive the designated vehicle via HZMB to the designated car testing centre with an appointment has been made for vehicle examination

Applicant

[Step 4: Renew the vehicle licence]

- Apply to the Licensing Offices of TD for renewal of the vehicle licence after the vehicle has passed the vehicle examination
