- Note 1: If the documents submitted by the applicant for eligibility assessment by this Department are still valid and could meet the required documentary requirements at the time of collecting the permit, the applicant may be exempted from submitting the same documents again when collecting the permit. Hong Kong cross boundary private cars holding Hong Kong regular quotas are not allowed to hold Macao car plates, otherwise they may incur corresponding legal liabilities. This Department may require the Closed Road Permit holders to provide supporting documents for checking their eligibilities for Quota Application during the quota validity period. If the holder does not meet the eligibilities, the TD may consider revoking the Closed Road Permit issued to relevant quota vehicle's upon verification.
- Note 2: During the quota validity period, if there is any information change of the vehicle registration document which was submitted in Hong Kong – Macao regular quota application, including but not limited to particular of registered vehicle owner or vehicle information (color, engine number or chassis number / vehicle identification number etc), the quota holder must inform TD (Cross Boundary Unit) and submit all required documents for the governments of Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao to process the change. Otherwise, the vehicle concerned may not be allowed to enter HZMB Hong Kong Port and Macao city centre by the law enforcement agency of the three governments. Besides, depending on the information changes areas of the vehicle registration document, applicants is responsible for ensuring that he/she is still possessing valid Mainland Compulsory Traffic Accident Liability Insurance and valid Macao Statutory Vehicle Insurance in order to avoid incurring any legal liability. If this Department receives notification from the relevant authorities of the Macao SAR Government that any particulars of the quota vehicles, when accessing Macao city centre, are inconsistent with its approved record, the TD may consider revoking the Closed Road Permit issued to relevant quota vehicle upon verification.
- Note 3: Not applicable to online submitted applications.
- Note 4: If the application form TD547D/TD547 of closed road permit for cross boundary vehicles is signed by the applicant, authorization letter is not required. For details please refer to the last page as attached with the application forms.
- Note 5: For change of driver applications within the validity period of the permit, the applicant only needs to submit the relevant documents of the new designated driver(s) (including: Consent Form of Designated Driver Original Copy, copy of Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card, copy of valid Hong Kong Driving Licence and copy of valid Mainland Driving Licence (both the front and side pages) (applicable to drivers reaching the age of 70)).
- Note 6: When applying and being issued with closed road permit, the vehicle must hold valid vehicle licence.
- Note 7: For the acceptable proof of address for this Department, please refer to [https://www.td.gov.hk/en/public\\_services/licences\\_and\\_permits/proof\\_of\\_address/index.html](https://www.td.gov.hk/en/public_services/licences_and_permits/proof_of_address/index.html) .
- If there is change in the permit holder's address, please notify the Cross Boundary Unit of the Transport Department (Room 1032, 10/F, Harbour Building, 38 Pier Road, Central, Hong Kong) of the change of address as soon as possible in writing, together with documentary proof of the new address.
- Note 8: If the designated driver is aged over 70, he/she must submit a copy of his/her Valid Mainland Driving Licence (both the front and side pages) to this Department for completion of the Mainland filing of records procedures.
- Note 9: For applications involving the renewal of vehicle registration documents, applicants are not required to return the original copy of their existing valid Closed Road Permit to this department. However, before applicants have been notified by this Department by email or call that the related application has been approved by the Macao and Mainland government authorities, please do not drive the quota vehicle accessing Macao City Centre in order to avoid incurring any legal liability.
- Note 10: In case the Closed Road Permit (CRP) is lost or damaged, the applicant may apply for a duplicate of the CRP. The application for a CRP duplicate should be made by the applicant in person using our application form(TD547) and be submitted to the Cross Boundary Unit of the Transport Department at Room 1032, 10/F, Harbour Building, 38 Pier Road, Central, Hong Kong. Upon submitting the application, the applicant is also

required to return the damaged CRP or the report of lost property issued by the Hong Kong Police Force. The application fee for a CRP duplicate is HK\$86.
