

Invitation for Expression of Interest (“EOI”)
for Operating the Rehabus Feeder Services (“Invitation”)

In 2018, the Transport Department (“TD”) of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government (“Government”) first invited interested parties (“Proponent”) to operate the Rehabus Feeder Services with effect from 1 June 2019 for a period of three years. Experience gained from subsequent years of operations has demonstrated that engaging another Rehabus operator can enhance operational efficiency in general.

2. In this regard, TD conducted another exercise in 2021 to select an operator to operate the Rehabus Feeder Services for a period of five years commencing in June 2022. As the operating right of the existing operator will expire soon, TD now invites submissions from Proponents to indicate their interest in operating the Rehabus Feeder Services. It is expected that the selected operator will commence the services on 1 June 2027 for a period of five years.

3. TD may, at its discretion, extend the operating right of the Rehabus Feeder Services for a further period or periods not exceeding five years at any one time, so that the total operating period granted, together with all extensions thereof, shall not in any case exceed ten years in aggregate.

4. The above Feeder Routes are existing services provided to the persons with disabilities (PWDs). The successful Proponent shall operate the Rehabus Feeder Services in accordance with a Service Agreement setting out the general principles and guidelines governing the role and responsibilities of the service provider to be signed between the Government as represented by TD and the successful Proponent at a later stage.

5. The Government will provide subvention and 23 rehabuses³ to the successful Proponent to manage, operate and maintain the Rehabus Feeder Services. The provision of any additional rehabuses to the successful Proponent will be subject to various factors, including without limitation, the availability of funding, passenger demand, satisfactory performance of the successful Proponent, and recurrent consequences on operating costs. All fares collected from the Rehabus Feeder Services should be kept by the successful Proponent to offset part of the operating expenditure.

6. The Proponent must, at the time of submission of the EOI proposal, be

a non-profit making organisation eligible for receiving direct Government subvention. For the avoidance of doubt, a non-profit making organisation must be a bona fide charitable institution or trust of a public character that is exempted from tax under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance (Cap. 112).

7. If there is more than one Proponent expresses interest in operating the Rehabus Feeder Services in response to this Invitation for EOI, the Government will conduct an Invitation for Proposals (“IOP”) exercise to select the most appropriate operator to provide the Rehabus Feeder Services. The successful Proponent shall:

- (a) sign a service agreement (“Service Agreement”) with the Government in form and substance to be determined by the Government; and
- (b) commence the operation of the Rehabus Feeder Services from 1 June 2027 or such date as may be specified by TD.

Purpose of invitation for EOI

8. This EOI exercise (“Exercise”) is neither an IOP exercise nor part of an IOP exercise. Neither this Exercise nor any submission received by the Government in response to this Exercise shall constitute an offer or form the basis of any contract, which may be concluded, nor are any of these documents binding on the Government. The Government has the unfettered discretion in whether or not to proceed with selecting the operator of the Rehabus Feeder Services by way of an IOP exercise and if so, whether or not to grant any applications so made in respect of the Rehabus Feeder Services.

Submission of proposals

9. Each Proponent shall submit its proposal comprising the following:
- (a) indicating its interest in operating the Rehabus Feeder Services as in the format set out in Annex 1;
 - (b) providing its particulars, including without limitation experience

and competence in public transport operations and management as in the format set out in Annex 2; and

- (c) providing the staff required, monthly recurrent resource required, service improvement proposals, and customer service plan as set out in the format set out in Annex 3.

10. The Proponent may provide any other relevant information and suggestions as it deems appropriate or necessary.

Reference materials

11. The information on the operational arrangements of the existing Rehabus Feeder Services is provided in Annex 4 for the Proponent's reference. The information provided in Annex 4 is the minimum requirements for the level of Rehabus Feeder Services to be operated by the Proponent shall it enter into the Service Agreement with the Government.

12. The specified forms (Annexes 1 to 3) and the reference materials (Annex 4) will be available for collection from 12.00 noon on 1 April 2026 (Wednesday). 13. All EOI submissions shall be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked with “**EOI for Operating the Rehabus Feeder Services**” and shall reach TD at the aforesaid address **on or before 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time), 21 April 2026 (Tuesday)**. In case a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or “extreme conditions”

announced by the Government is/are in force, for any duration between 9.00 a.m. (Hong Kong Time) and 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on 21 April 2026 (Tuesday), the submission closing time will be extended to 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) of the following working day. **Late submissions will NOT be considered.** For the purpose of this paragraph, “working day” means a day excluding any Saturdays, general holidays within the meaning of the General Holidays Ordinance (Cap. 149), and a day on which a tropical cyclone waning signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or “extreme conditions” announced by the Government is/are in force, for any duration between 9.00 a.m. (Hong Kong Time) and 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time).

Government’s rights and disclaimers

14. By making a submission in response to this Invitation, the Proponent shall be taken to have accepted all the terms of this Invitation.

15. The Government reserves the right to change any of the operational arrangements and any other specifications relating to the Rebus Feeder Services in this Invitation, or in considering any application in any future IOP exercise therefor, or to cancel this Exercise and not to consider any proposal or not to grant any operation right.

16. All costs and expenses involved in the preparation and submission of the EOI in response to this Invitation shall be borne solely by the Proponents.

17. All information and statistics contained in this Invitation and the attached specified forms are provided to facilitate the Proponent’s preparation of its submission of EOI only. The Government does not warrant or represent (whether expressly or impliedly) as to the correctness, accuracy, completeness, reliability, timeliness or fitness for a particular purpose of any such information and statistics. In particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, no representation or warranty is given as to the achievement or reasonableness of any future projections or estimates contained in the Invitation. Nothing in this Invitation, or in any other written or oral information which is, has been or will be provided or made available to any Proponent, shall be relied on as a representation, statement or warranty as to the intentions, policy or action

in future of the Government, its officers or agents. The Government does not accept any liability to any person howsoever caused by the use of or reliance on any such information and statistics. The Proponent should conduct its own independent assessment of the information and statistics contained in this invitation document and seek professional advice if it deems necessary.

18. The participation in the Exercise shall be entirely at the Proponent's own risk. The Government will not under any circumstances be liable to any Proponent for any costs, expense, loss or damage whatsoever arising out of or in connection with this Invitation or any EOI submission, irrespective of whether the Government eventually proceeds with the selection of an operator for the Rehabus Feeder Services.

Personal data of the Proponent

19. The personal data of the Proponent and of any individual provided as part of the EOI submission (collectively referred to as "personal data" in paragraphs 19 to 22) will be used by the Government for the purposes of this Invitation, and all other purposes arising from or incidental to it (including for the purposes of processing the EOI submission, and all other purposes necessary for or directly related to the said purposes including but not limited to the resolution of any dispute arising from this Invitation and/or the EOI submission and disclosure pursuant to paragraph 20.

20. By submission of an EOI, the Proponent acknowledges and consents and has ensured that the individuals who are the subject of personal data have acknowledged and consented that personal data provided in the EOI submission may be disclosed to other Government Bureaux and Departments, the Legislative Council, the District Councils, non-governmental organisations and data access applicants under the Code of Access to Information.

21. Nothing in paragraph 20 of this Invitation will prejudice the Government's power to disclose, whenever it considers appropriate, information of any nature whatsoever in relation to or concerning any Proponent or its EOI submission if the disclosure is made under any one of the following circumstances:

- (a) the disclosure of any information to any public officer or public body as defined in the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) or any other person employed, used or engaged by the Government (including agents, advisers, contractors and consultants);
- (b) the disclosure of any information already known to the recipient;
- (c) the disclosure of any information which is public knowledge;
- (d) the disclosure of any information in circumstances where such disclosure is required pursuant to any law of Hong Kong or an order of a court of Hong Kong or a court or tribunal with competent jurisdiction;
- (e) the disclosure of any information regarding anti-competitive collusive conduct to the Competition Commission of Hong Kong (and other authorities as relevant); or
- (f) without prejudice to the power of the Government under paragraph 20 of this Invitation, to the extent the information relates to or concerns a Proponent, with the prior written consent of that Proponent.

22. The Proponent and the individuals who are the subject of personal data, and persons authorised respectively by the Proponent and such individuals in writing have the right of access and correction with respect to personal data as provided for in Sections 18 and 22 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486). The right of access includes the right to obtain a copy of the personal data provided in the EOI submission.

In making a submission, the Proponent shall be deemed to have granted and shall upon the demand of the Government at the Proponent's cost, procure that the lawful owner or authorised person of the relevant intellectual property rights will grant, to the Government a licence to use, reproduce, adapt, modify its EOI submission and to otherwise exercise all intellectual property rights subsisting therein for all purposes in respect of or in connection with this invitation. "Use" includes doing any acts restricted by copyright set out in Sections 22 to 29 of the Copyright Ordinance (Cap. 528). The Proponent shall, if required by the Government, do all things and execute all instruments or documents for the purpose of conferring such rights on the Government. Such right and licence shall continue to subsist so long as any intellectual property rights subsist in the EOI submission under any applicable law, including the Laws of Hong Kong.
