Subject : Agreement for Management, Operation and Maintenance of Tsing Ma Control Area and Provision of Towing Services on North Lantau Highway and Sections of Roads in Penny's Bay

Description : The successful tenderer will be required to undertake the following duties:

- (a) management and operation of Tsing Ma Control Area, including:
 - (i) taking enforcement actions under the applicable ordinances and regulations;
 - (ii) collection of tolls, approved fees and charges;
 - (iii) regulation of traffic;
 - (iv) patrolling and security of the Tsing Ma Control Area;
 - (v) handling incidents occurred within the Tsing Ma Control Area;
 - (vi) recovery and removal of broken down vehicles;
 - (vii) cleansing of the Tsing Ma Control Area; and
 - (viii) high wind management at Lantau Link and Ting Kau Bridge
- (b) operation and maintenance of the electrical and mechanical equipment and electronic systems of the Tsing Ma Control Area, including but not limited to:
 - (i) power supply system;
 - (ii) lighting system;
 - (iii) ventilation system;
 - (iv) toll collection system; and
 - (v) traffic control and surveillance system;
- (c) carrying out scheduled maintenance works for the Tsing Ma Control Area including regular inspection, routine maintenance and repair of the civil works, buildings, bridges, tunnel, structures, systems, computer software, traffic signs and signals, with the exception of the Airport Railway and areas under the control of MTR Corporation Limited within Tsing Ma Control Area;
- (d) carrying out non-scheduled maintenance works for the Tsing Ma Control Area and supervision of such works as directed by the Government with the costs to be reimbursed by the Government;

- (e) selection and appointment of advertising agent(s) for displaying advertisements at approved locations within the Tsing Ma Control Area; and
- (f) provision of towing services on North Lantau Highways and Sections of Roads in Penny's Bay.

The duration of the agreement shall be six (6) years commencing on 19 November 2019 or on a date the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region shall specify.

Late tenders or tenders not deposited in the Government Secretariat Tender Box will not be accepted. Submission of Tenders/Applications : Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated at the Lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor of East Wing of Central Government Offices, 2 Time Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 10 May 2019.

Remarks : The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender, and reserves the right to negotiate with any tenderer about the terms of the

offer.
