Subject: Agreement for Management, Operation and Maintenance of the Route 6

Description: The successful tenderer will be required to undertake the following major duties, including:

- (a) management and operation of the tunnels, including:
 - (i) collection of approved fees and charges;
 - (ii) control and regulation of traffic and law enforcement under applicable ordinances and regulations;
 - (iii) patrolling and security; and
 - (iv) incident management within the tunnel area including recovery and removal of broken vehicles;
- (b) operation and maintenance of the electrical and mechanical equipment and electronic systems of the tunnels, mainly including:
 - (i) power supply system;
 - (ii) tunnel lighting system;
 - (iii) ventilation system; and
 - (iv) traffic control and surveillance system;
- (c) providing non-structural maintenance and repairing works for the upkeep of the tunnels including tunnel cleansing work; and
- (d) constructing advertising structures (at Government's cost) and engaging advertising agent(s) for displaying advertisements within the tunnel area, if required.

The duration of the agreement shall be four (4) years commencing on a date the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region shall specify by notice.

Collection of Tender Documents: The tender documents are obtainable during office hours from 24 January 2025 (Friday) from the Business Management Section of the Transport Department on the 14th Floor, South Tower, West Kowloon Government Offices, 11 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei, Kowloon (Tel.: 3842 5867; Fax: 2877 5768).

To facilitate tenderers in accessing tender information, downloading tender documents and submitting tenders electronically, the Government has developed and launched an electronic tendering system, namely e-Tendering

System (“e-TS”). Tenderers may download the tender documents and/or submit tenders electronically for this tender before the tender closing time via e-TS at https://www.ets.gov.hk/eTp_ext/views/tenderDtlsDirect.zul?token=64908474c16abf9f93c391c0a32e2d8a3d4e41cead7052b4ed6df1b14238a689. Submission of Tenders/Applications: For paper-based tendering, tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated at the Lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor of East Wing of Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong **before 12:00 noon on Friday, 21 March 2025** (Hong Kong time). Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice (“Specified Tender Box”) before the tender closing time. For electronic tendering, transmission of a tender through the e-TS shall be successfully completed in accordance with the requirement of the e-TS before the tender closing time. Late tenders or tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

- Remarks:**
- (i) If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or “extreme conditions” announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on 21 March 2025 (Friday) (Hong Kong time), the tender closing time will be postponed to 12:00 noon (Hong Kong time) on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the “extreme conditions” announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force.
 - (ii) In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on 21 March 2025 (Friday) (Hong Kong time), the Government will announce the extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following the removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. The above announcements will be made via press releases on the website of the Information Services Department (<http://www.info.gov.hk/gia/general/today.htm>).
 - (iii) Open tendering is adopted. All interested contractors are invited to tender.

- (iv) The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region does not bind itself to accept the tender with the highest overall score or any tender, and reserves the right to negotiate with any tenderer about the terms of the offer.
