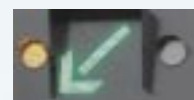


TUNNEL AREA END  
隧道區域終止

一般守則

- 與前車保持安全距離。
- 留意交通標誌及行車線信號。當黃色燈號閃動時，要小心慢速駕駛並準備停車。
- 不得換線、超越前車或掉頭。
- 當隧道內的交通因事故而停頓時，請忍讓並留在車廂內。
- 遵從隧道職員的指示。
- 遵守交通標誌、道路標記、行車線信號及車速限制。
- 遵守車輛長度、寬度、高度、載重及拖車限制。
- 遵守有關法例。

在繳費廣場駕駛時

- 遵守每小時50公里的車速限制。
- 選定繳費模式。
- 遵守道路標記及交通標誌

- 開啟收音機，留意隧道公司的廣播消息。
- 不得換線、超越前車或掉頭。
- 於隧道內使用低燈。

駕駛人士遵守以下在隧道內的  
安全駕駛守則，可確保旅程安全愉快。

KEEP IN LANE  
不准換綫

當遇上壞車、火警或交通意外時  
(在肇事車輛內的司機及乘客)

- 熄掉引擎，留下車匙。
- 亮起危險警告燈號。
- 留意其他行車線上正在行駛的車輛，在安全情況下離開車輛。
- 用隧道管道內的緊急電話通知隧道控制中心。
- 打破火警鐘玻璃，以啟動火警鐘。
- 站在路壁以遠離危險
- 等候隧道職員協助及遵從其指示。
- 在情況及能力許可下，幫助其他人士。在火警發生時，可嘗試用隧道管道旁的滅火筒救火，但須避開濃煙及小心車輛。

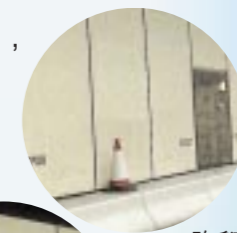

當前車遇上故障、交通意外  
或發生火警時

- 不可試圖越過雙白線以超越肇事車輛。
- 與肇事車輛保持安全距離並留在車廂內。
- 亮起危險警告燈號。
- 開啟收音機，留意隧道公司的廣播消息及遵從隧道職員的指示。
- 在情況及能力許可下，可嘗試協助救人或救火，但須避開濃煙及小心車輛。
- 假如司機及乘客需要下車，應熄掉引擎，留下車匙，並留在路壁以遠離火場及濃煙。
- 在沒有隧道職員的指示下，不應沿路壁走出隧道管道、亦不應嘗試穿過隧道分隔門到另一條隧道管道及棄置車輛。

當火警/事故發生時，巴士車長應該

- 用隧道管道內的緊急電話通知隧道控制中心。
- 通知車上乘客火警/事故的類別及應變措施。
- 要求乘客保持鎮定及遵從巴士車長及隧道職員的指示。
- 等候隧道職員的協助。
- 照顧車上乘客。

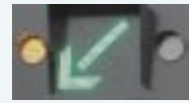
當火警 / 事故發生，

隧道安全守則  
Tunnel Safety Guidelines

## General guidelines

- Keep a safe distance from the vehicle in front.
- Pay attention to the traffic signs and lane signals. When the flashing yellow signal is on, drive slowly with extra care and prepare to stop.
- Do not change lanes, overtake another vehicle or U-turn.
- Be patient to stoppage of traffic due to incident inside the tunnel tube and stay in the vehicle.
- Follow instructions given by tunnel staff.
- Comply with the traffic signs, road markings, lane signals and speed limit imposed.
- Comply with length, width, height, weight and vehicle towing restriction.
- Comply with relevant legislations.

### When driving in toll plaza

- Observe the speed limit of 50km/hr.
- Determine the payment method.
- Comply with the road markings and traffic signs

### When driving inside tunnel tube

- Turn on the radio to listen to broadcasted message from tunnel company.
- Do not change lanes, overtake another vehicle or U-turn
- Use dipped headlamps in tunnels.

## Motorists who observe the following safety rules in tunnel areas will enjoy a safe and smooth driving.

### In the event of vehicle breakdown, fire or accident (For driver and passengers on subject vehicle)

- Switch off the engine, leave the key in the ignition.
- Switch on hazard warning lights.
- Leave the vehicle when it is safe to do so, caution should be taken to moving traffic on other lanes.
- Inform the tunnel control room by emergency telephone inside the tunnel.
- Activate the break-glass fire alarm in the event of fire.
- Stand on kerb to stay away from the danger.
- Wait for assistance and follow the instructions of tunnel staff.
- If situation allows, give assistance to other people. In case of fire, try to use the fire extinguisher placed at the side of tunnel tube to put out the fire. When doing so, stay away from the direction of smoke and exercise caution to the moving traffic.

### If there is a fire/incident, bus captains should

- Inform the tunnel control room by emergency telephone inside the tunnel.
- Inform passengers on board about the fire/incident and the contingency arrangements.
- Advise passengers to keep calm and follow the instructions given by bus captain and tunnel staff.
- Wait for assistance from tunnel staff.
- Take care of the passengers.

### When the vehicle in front has broken down or an accident or is on fire

- Do not attempt to overtake the subject vehicle by crossing the double white lines.
- Keep a safe distance from the subject vehicle and stay in vehicles.
- Switch on hazard warning lights.
- Turn on radio to listen to broadcasted message from tunnel company and follow instructions from tunnel staff.
- If situation allows, try to rescue the people trapped or assist in putting out the fire. When doing so, stay away from the direction of smoke and exercise caution to the moving traffic.
- If drivers and passengers need to leave their vehicles, switch off the engine, leave the key in the ignition and stay at the kerb away from fire and smoke.
- Without guidance and instructions from tunnel staff, do not walk out of the tunnel tube along the kerb, nor try to go to the neighboring tunnel tube through the cross-passage doors and leave the vehicle unattended.

### If there is a fire/incident, bus passengers should

- Keep calm.
- Listen to and follow the instructions given by bus captain and tunnel staff.
- Give assistance to passengers who need help.
